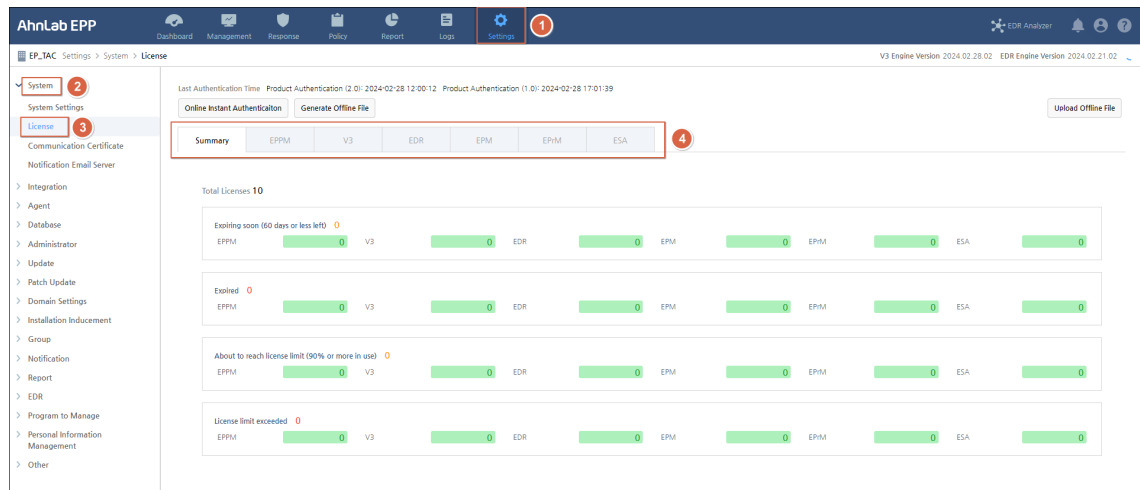

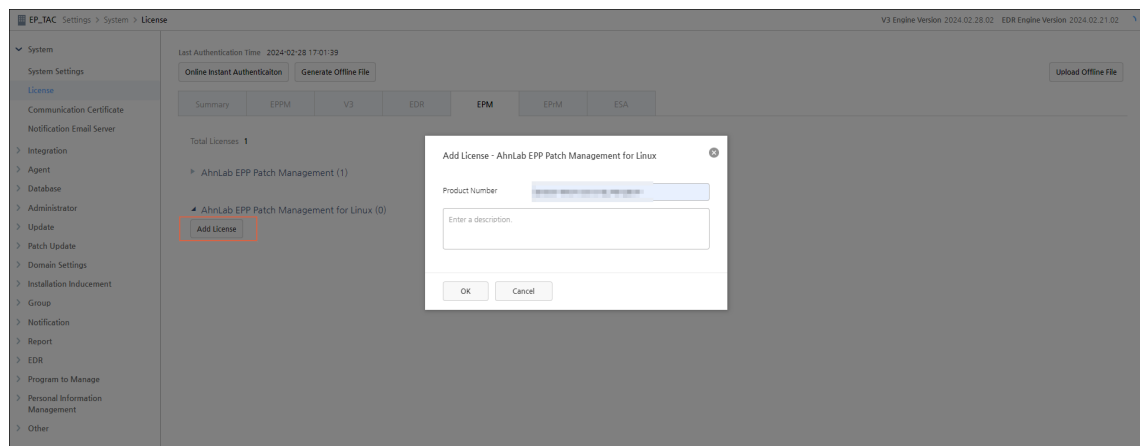

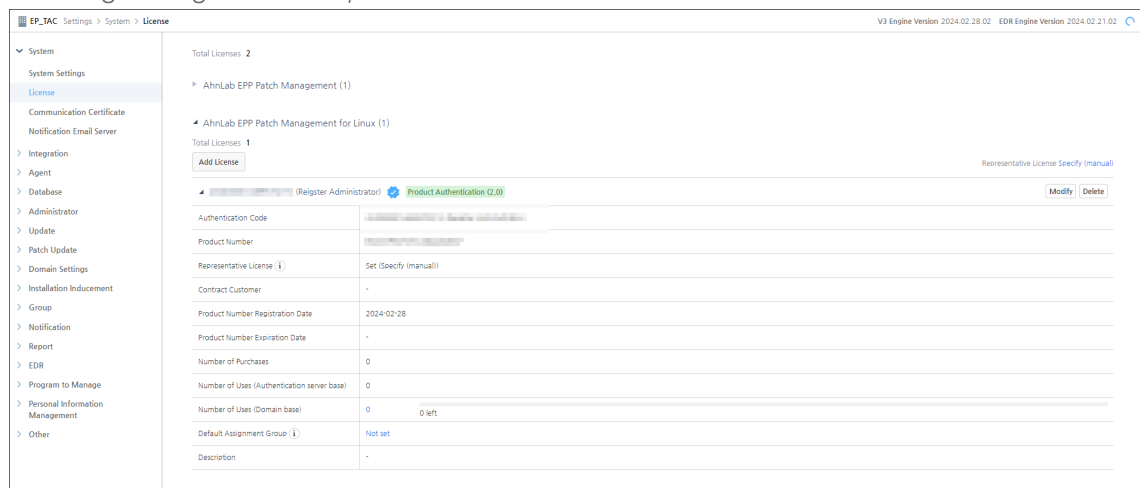
- You can register license for desired plugin product in the following way.
