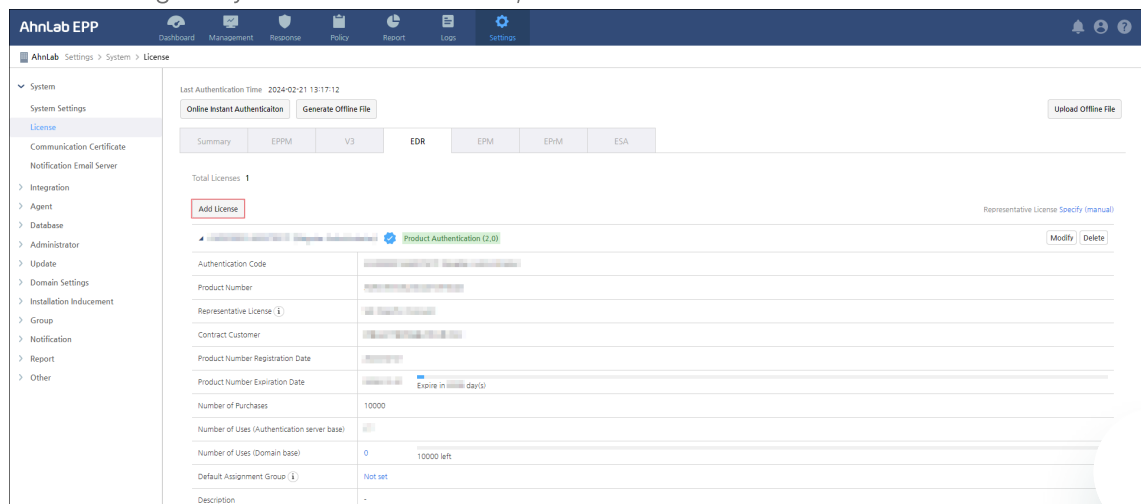
1. Overview

- This article describes how to register a domain after installing EPP and EDR.

2. Content

2-1) Enter a license.

- Go to Settings > System > License > EDR, and then click Add License.

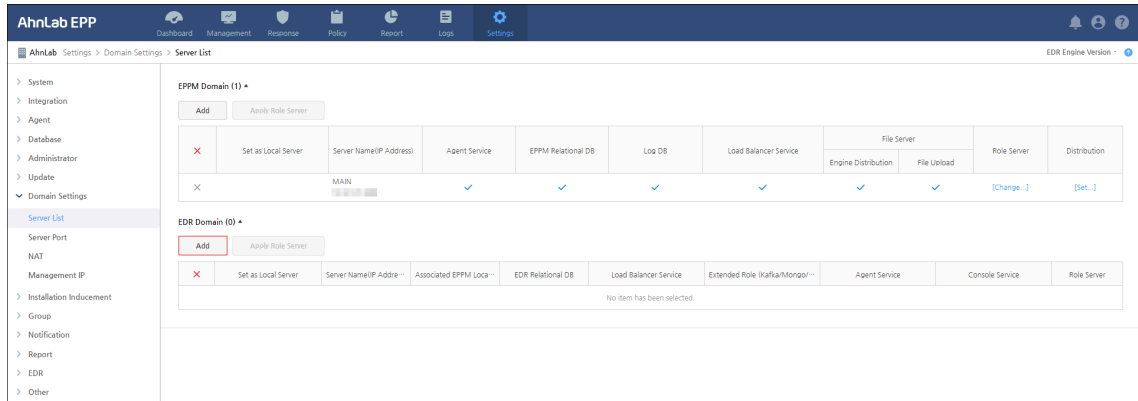


- Proceed with Online or Offline Authentication.

2-2) Log out from the web console and then log in again.

2-3) Proceed to add EDR domain.

- Go to Settings > Domain Settings > Server List, and then click Add in EDR Domain



- Enter the name, IP Address, Server Management Key (server key) of the EDR Server, and then click OK.

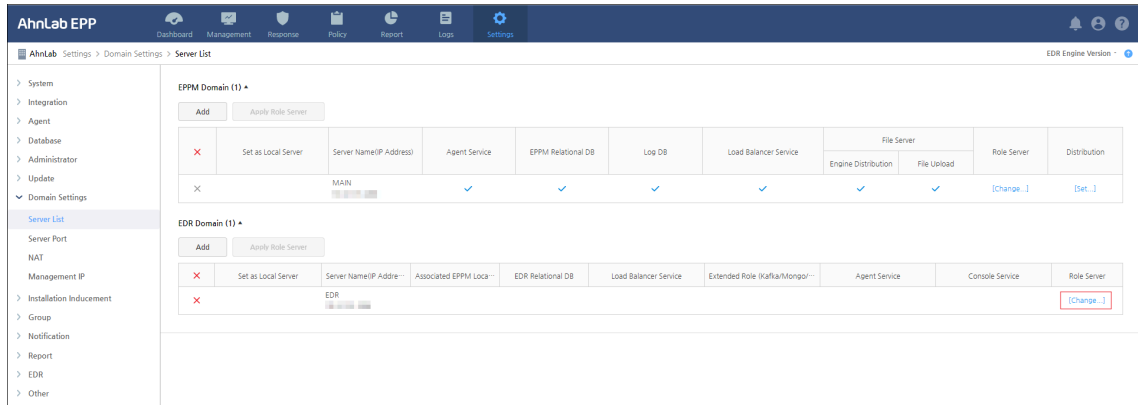
In NAT environment, be sure to set a public IP address in Domain Settings > NAT Settings after registering the domain.

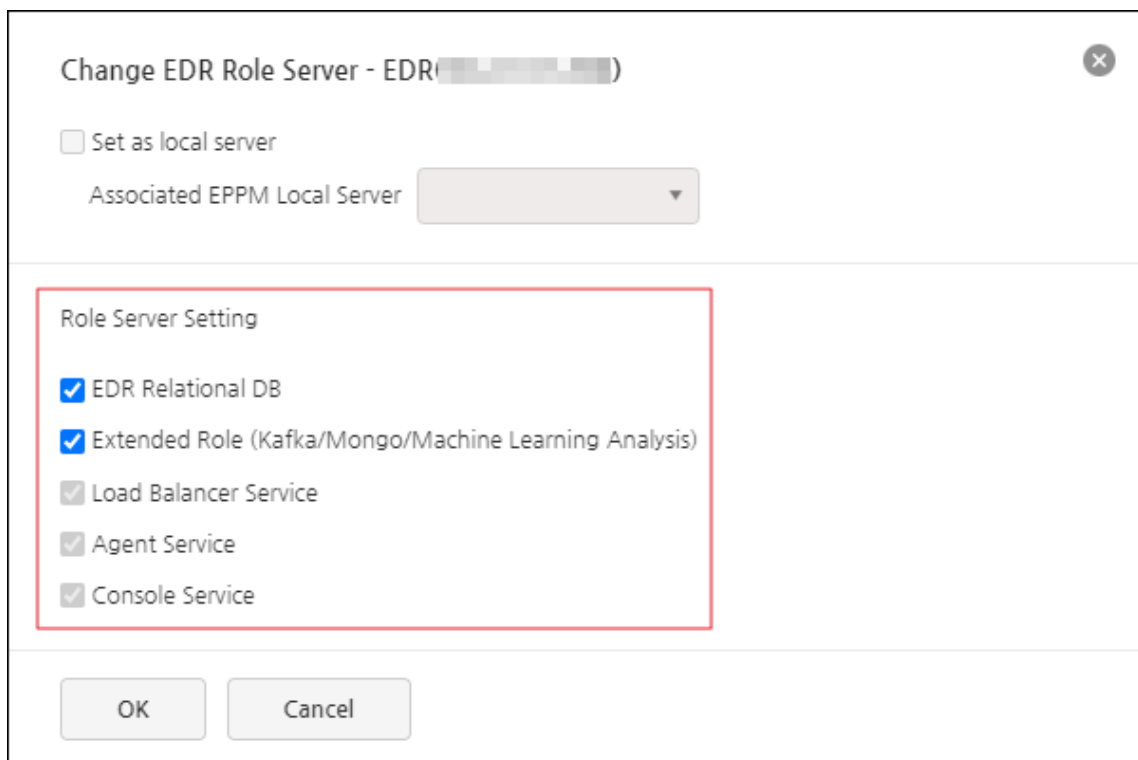

2-4) Click on [Change...] below Role Server in EDR Domain, and then set up the role.

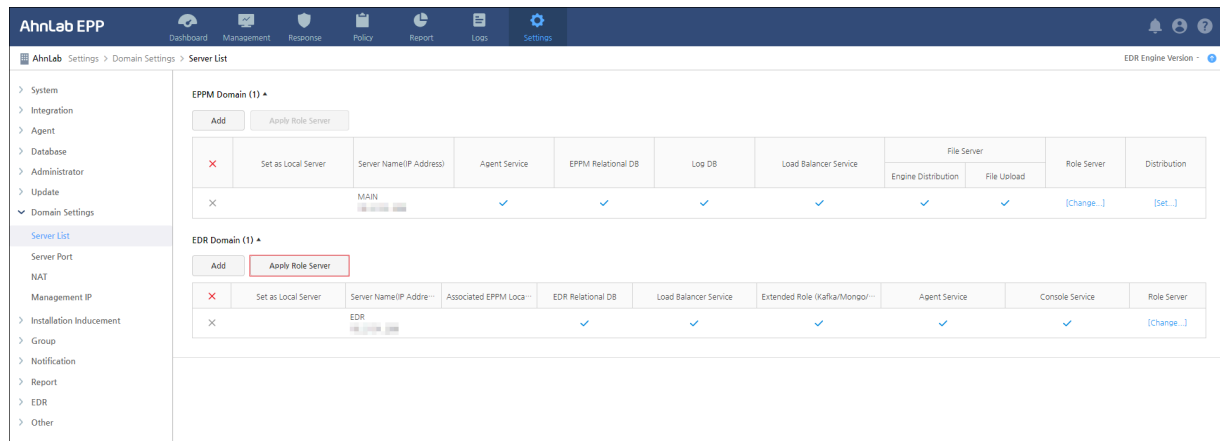
- Go to Role Server, and then click [Change...].



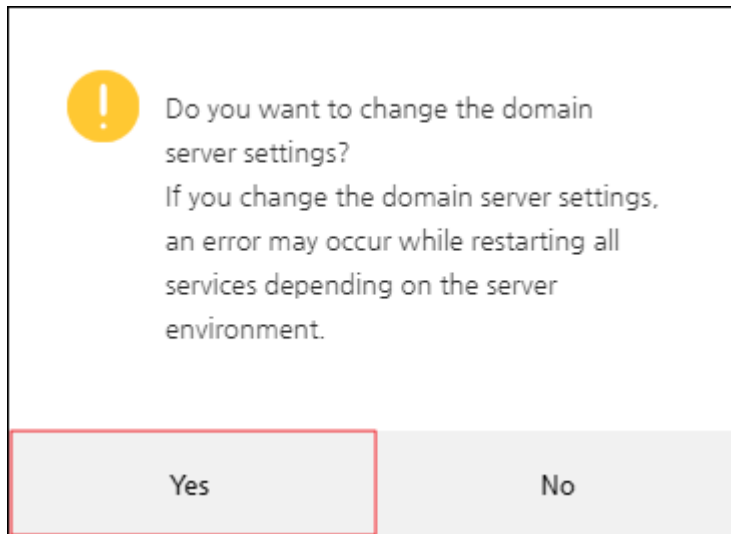
- Select all 5 types of roles.
 - EDR Relational DB
 - Extended Role (Kafka/Mongo/Machine Learning Analysis)
 - Load Balancer Service
 - Agent Service
 - Console Service



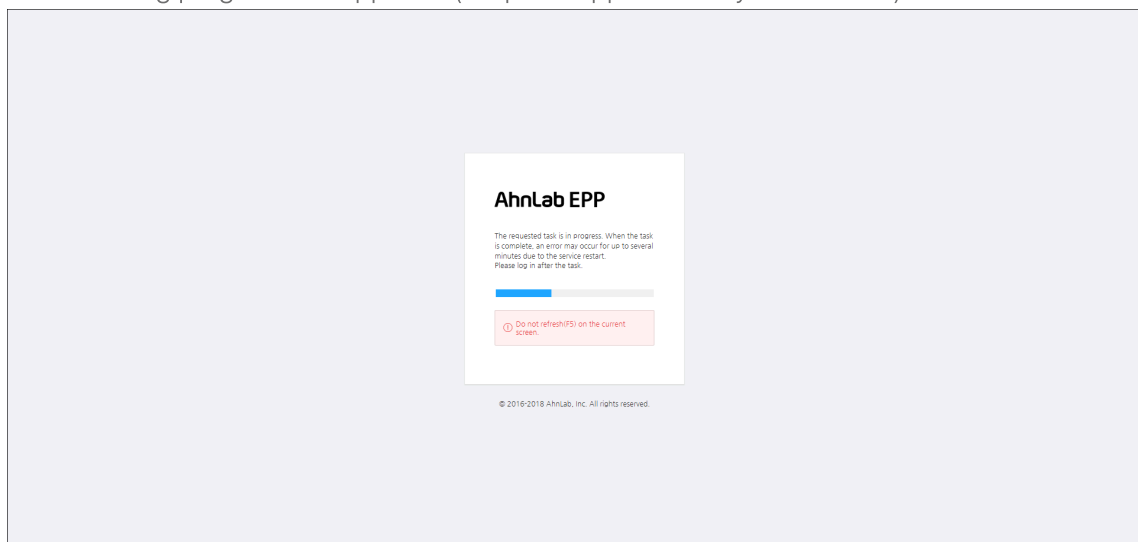
2-5) Click on the 'Apply Role Server' button.



- Click 'Yes' on the pop-up window.

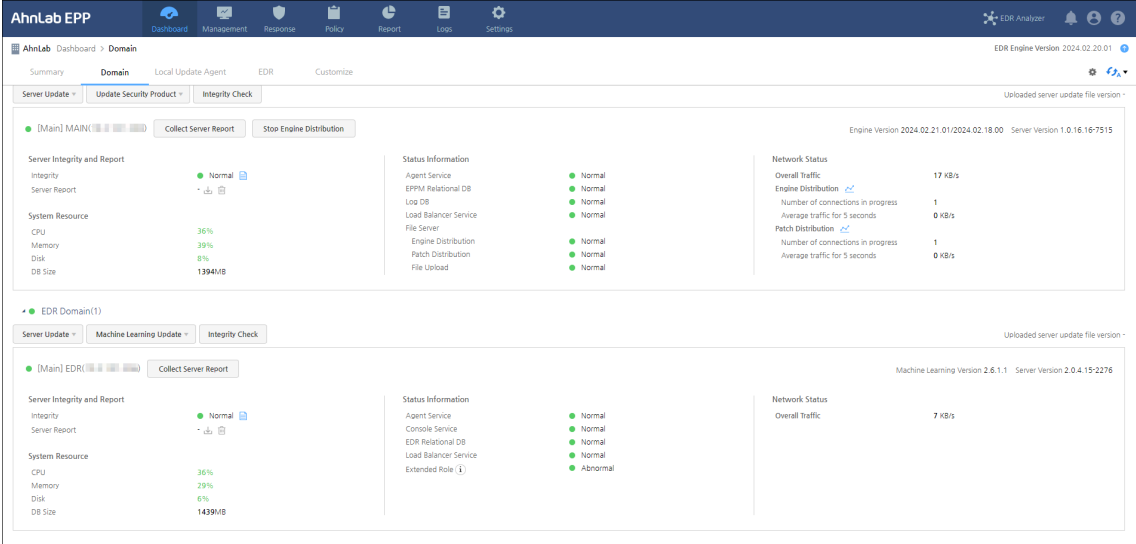


- The following progress bar appears. (Requires approximately 20 minutes)



2-6) Once the progress bar finishes, log back into the web console.

- Go to Dashboard > Domain to check if the EDR Domain has been properly applied.
